Urgent, last minute request: next humanitarian aid mission August 12-17, 2012!

- Nurchers has partnered with the Haitian NGO: CEHAH for our August trip! We desperately need more meds and supplies! I can pre-pay for any meds shipped to me that we can carry in to the compound in Jacmel with us. We could use:
 - thermometers,
 - any antifebrile,
 - anti-inflammatory,
 - Baby Tylenol,
 - b/p meds,
 - Antibiotic eye/ear drops (any AB).
 - Saline "bullets"---these are GREAT for cleaning and debriding skin issues or flushing eyes and doing any type dressing changes in the field tent clinic.
 - Any vitamins, vaccines.
 - Anything that will soon expire that docs or hospitals feel they will not utilize by month end (by the end of Aug.) we can use as the trip is Aug. 12-17.
- We are going into Jacmel (a remote area of Haiti) to help 300+ patients per day. The only supplies will be what we carry in, what we left behind last trip and, if we have enough resources, we can buy some meds on ground through a trusted local source that Dr. Bonnet has provided, as well as ground transportation and security to and from the tent clinic each day. CEHAH, an NGO, is providing food, lodging, a Haitian doctor, a Canadian nurse and a translator at the site each day.
- We still need medical supplies and donations to purchase water while there (helps in the field tent to keep the workers hydrated and also helps in dispensing meds).

Sparta middle school "adopted" their nurse, Nurse Lil, to help sponsor her trip! With coordination by Patty Godzenovich, the children raised \$485! Please know that EVERY cent goes to the work of helping our brothers and sisters (many, many times they are babies). What we cannot collect ahead of time and desperately need I pay for personally. We have been blessed with resources and fabulous nurse/angels to be able to send in 8 nurses. Please help in any way! *This will be Nurchers 4th trip in 18 months.*
